

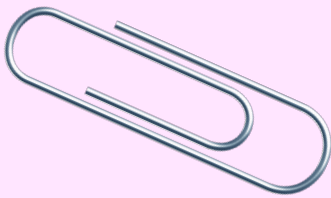
POSITIVE CHARACTERISTICS OF AUTISTIC WORKERS
